INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

This paper is for the use of the supervisor only, in consultation with the Art teacher. Attention is directed to the syllabi and to the standing instructions as given in the subject syllabus.

NB. *Candidates must be instructed that ruling by any means whatsoever is forbidden. The Art Teacher should supply the candidates with cards measuring 5cm wide by 12 cm long with which the candidates will demarcate the area in the top right – hand corner of the front surface of the paper. In this area, the candidate's name, centre and index numbers, in that order, must be written clearly. This area must not be painted.*

The setter of the groups of objects in this paper must interpret the sides mentioned in the questions set below i.e. left or right according to the position of the candidates facing the objects.

The Headmaster should ensure that the teachers in charge of preparing specimens do not substitute specimens specified in the early instructions with other specimens of their choice otherwise the candidates' work will be considered irrelevant and hence will not be marked or graded.

Either A,

On the floor near the wall, place a metallic charcoal stove approximately 30cm in diameter with the air outlet facing candidates.

On top of the stove, put a medium size source pan approximately 26cm in diameter tilted to face the right side.

On the right side slightly in front of the stove, put a ten litre jerrican in a $\frac{3}{4}$ view facing the left side.

On the left side put an axe with a handle to lean on the wall and the saucepan. In front of the stove near the jerrican heap about 2kgs of charcoal without covering the air outlet.

Or B.



On a low platform near the wall in front of the candidates, place a traditional coiled basket containing a big cabbage, water melon and pawpaw together with 2 oranges, 2 onions, 2 tomatoes and two egg plants.

On the left side, put a rolled up papyrus mat approximately 60cm high to lean on the wall and the basket.

Put a small pumpkin in between the mat and the basket and a kitchen knife to cut one of the fruits in the basket.

Or C.

Make a study or studies of a freshly transplanted banana sucker approximately 40cm high with roots and leaves intact.

Or D.

Candidates should draw or paint a long time abandoned construction site with a truck parked in front of the site and trees seen in the background.
